**Mohawk College Bridge** is a double-period Dual Credit program where students have the opportunity to earn secondary school credits and Mohawk College credits, concurrently. Students spend the morning at their home school and then the afternoon (periods 4 and 5) at Mohawk College's [Institute for Applied Health Sciences at McMaster University Campus](#).

### Successful completion of this program will result in students earning:

- two (2) elective secondary school credits, which count toward the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) **AND**,
- two (2) college level credits, recorded on a Mohawk College transcript, that can count toward a post-secondary certificate, diploma, applied degree, or apprenticeship certification.

### Semester 2 Health Care (PM) Bridge Course Descriptions:

**HSCI 10235 Structure and Function of the Human Body** - Examine the normal structures and functions of the human body and its system. This is an introduction to anatomy preparatory course that will build the foundation for many post secondary health care programs (PHW4T)

**COMM 10380 Communication for Personal Support Workers** - Communication for Personal Support Work intensive is an introductory college level English course. Students exiting this course will demonstrate competence in grammar, sentence structure, oral and writing skills. Successful students in this course will develop the reading, writing, critical and analytical skills essential to them as communicators in college and upon graduation in the Personal Support Worker field. This course teaches writing through the critical reading of various fiction and non-fiction material and brings students to college level foundation skills. COMM 11000 Essentials of Communication Mohawk course equivalent (HDC4T)

This program is open to HWCDSB grade 11, 12 12+ students who have not yet graduated from secondary school.
